The paper will not be included in the conference proceedings if the authors have not registered at the Conference.

Only the papers presented at the Conference will be reviewed and published in a special issue of an International Journal, Scopus indexed.

Authors of 10 high quality papers will be invited to submit their paper in a completed form for peer review and publication in the *International Journal of Heat and Technology*.

5 Certificates of Merit will be assigned during the Conference, to be devoted to young graduates, PhD and post PhD students and young researchers, who have carried out significant research work on the Conference issues and present their results with a paper, in oral or poster sessions:
