

Memorandum of Understanding

Japan Society of Refrigerating and Air Conditioning Engineers
and
Italian Association for Air Conditioning, Heating, Refrigeration

Purpose

In recognition of shared technical interests, the Japan Society of Refrigerating and Air Conditioning Engineers (JSRAE) and the Italian Association for Air Conditioning, Heating, Refrigeration (AiCARR) agree to support this Memorandum of Understanding to advance and promote the mutual interests of science- and engineering professionals.

Liaison meeting

Recognizing the importance of communication in the organization collaboration, both organizations commit to hold a liaison -meeting (either in person, via conference call or alternatives) of designates JSRAE and AiCARR representatives as necessary. It ensures ongoing advancement of collaborative projects and discusses new opportunities for collaboration. Action items with assigned responsibility shall be recorded at each meeting.

Areas of common interest

JSRAE and AiCARR identify the following opportunities for collaboration, but are not limited to them:

1. Encourage continuing dialogue between the organizations at all levels on issues of importance to researchers, engineers, and equipment professionals
2. Both organizations agree to share products and services prepared with respective members without impairing the value of membership in either organization
 - a. *Where mutual beneficial, jointly identify, create, and implement new products and services including:*
 - i. Regional conferences that encourage the exchange of developing engineering solutions.
 - ii. Training and certification programs.
 - iii. Publications.
3. Both organizations agree to proactively explore opportunities to translate AiCARR technical documents into Japanese and to translate JSRAE technical documents into Italian.
 - a. *Both organizations agree to respect each organization's intellectual property rights.*

4. Each organization agrees to provide the other with:
 - a. *One complimentary VIP registration to the organization's primary annual meeting.*
 - b. *One complimentary subscription to each printing or digital magazine.*
5. Both organizations agree to work together HVAC&R issues
 - a. *Each organization will bring its member expertise to bear on establishing a research agenda and prioritizing research projects.*
6. Both organizations agree to discuss ways to promote adoption and widespread use of codes, standards, guidelines and vademecum related to mutual interest

Each organization recognize the unique and varying concerns of the other and neither organization will interpret or impose conditions herein to prevent the other organization from fulfilling these missions. Each organization will give proper recognition to each other for individual and joint efforts in reporting to their respective membership and to the public.

This MOU reflects a commitment by both organizations to continue and enhance their working relation and individual efforts toward achieving mutual objects especially those described above. It does not create a binding obligation or agreement between the organizations, and neither organization has an obligation to negotiate toward or enter into a binding writing agreement. In addition, this MOU does not create a partnership, joint venture, fiduciary relation, or similar agreement between the organizations. Either organization may terminate this MOU, with or without stated causes, upon providing the organization with 30 days written notice of intent to terminate. Furthermore, it is understood that this MOU is conceived as a dynamic document, mean to changes as circumstances and priorities warrant, that it is a beginning point and that any protocol of specific projects and activities developed is intended as an integral part of this understanding.
